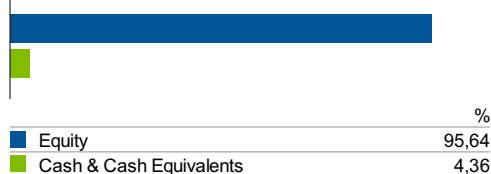
### Summary of Investment Objective
